It is managed by a small London-based team alongside its sister charity, Arcadia ([www.arcadiafund.org.uk](http://www.arcadiafund.org.uk)). We are looking for a Grants Manager to help develop a portfolio of grants and funding programmes to meet that aim.

You will:

- Identify and research opportunities to make grants and create funding programmes.
- Make recommendations and give advice to our Board.
- Manage a portfolio of grants and funding programmes.
- Share what we learn from our research and portfolio through our website, social media and networks.

You must have:

- The ability to understand, interpret, and analyse data, and experience of managing or conducting research.
- Experience advising or making recommendations to decision-makers (eg, a board, senior management etc).
- The ability to write for and present to different audiences including non-specialists.
- Demonstrable knowledge of, and interest in, the environment and conservation work in the UK or beyond. This may be from studies, work or volunteering, and may come from a variety of perspectives (conservation practice, academia, grant-making, community work etc).

We offer an excellent benefits package including 25 days of annual leave, an employer contribution-only pension scheme, life assurance, private medical and dental cover and an employer-matched Give As You Earn programme. The role is based in our offices near Charing Cross Station in central London which we share with Arcadia. We support flexible working: our current policy is for staff to be in the office a minimum of three days a week between 10am and 3pm.
